Storm Warriors Safety Rally to offer important survival tips with educational opportunities for the public

WEATHERFORD (CITY OF WEATHERFORD), Texas - The City of Weatherford Public Library will host the Storm Warrior Safety Rally in collaboration with the Doss Heritage and Culture Center, Thursday, July 27, located at 1400 Texas Drive beginning at 5 p.m. and concluding at 8 p.m. Patrons will have the opportunity to learn important storm safety tips and discover ways to better prepare for severe weather.

Opening statements will be made by Emergency Management Coordinator Cody Mulloy with special guest appearances by meteorologist Dan Brounoff and National Weather Service (NWS)/National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) official Greg Story. The Storm Warrior team will provide an educational presentation for attendees, along with a question and answer session. Other special presentations will be given by the Weatherford Fire Department, Weatherford Police Department and Life Care. Attendees will also have the opportunity to tour first responder vehicles.

“The Storm Warrior Safety Rally is an educational opportunity that teaches storm safety and introduces attendees to local public safety officials,” said Community and Events Librarian Rachel Reeves. “The rally is for all ages and is a collaborative effort to better educate the public. We are so excited to host the Storm Warriors in our community.”

Storm Warriors is a television show that follows the real life adventures of Weatherford residents Bill Ford and his wife, Danielle and their two children Cori and Noah as they track the most violent weather events on earth. They are joined by veteran storm trackers, Mike Casey and Mike Prendergast and together they seek to warn, assist and restore communities in the path of nature’s fury.

“Just like our TV show, Storm Warriors will be teaching important survival tips to attendees when facing severe weather,” said Storm Warrior Team Captain Bill Ford. “We hope the event better prepares the public and we look forward to coming to Weatherford.”
